The Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) has no objections to the proposed application as the supplemental information provided in the application does not affect the waste management service provided. The review updates a previous response, dated February 15, 2013, as the applicant is currently providing revisions to the site and floor plans.

According to Chapter 15 of the Miami-Dade Code, entitled Solid Waste Management, jewelry store on the property will likely be considered a commercial establishment. As the PWWM does not actively compete for commercial waste collection service at this time, waste collection services may be provided by a private waste hauler.

The PWWM does not assess or adjust estimated waste disposal capacity requirements based on the impacts of individual developments. Instead, the Department maintains sufficient disposal capacity to accommodate five years of waste flows committed to the System through long-term interlocal agreements or contracts with municipalities and private waste haulers and anticipated non-committed waste flows. The PWWM is in compliance with this standard, meaning that there is adequate disposal capacity to meet projected growth in demand, inclusive of the application reviewed here, which is not anticipated to have a negative impact on disposal service.
